



REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO CONDUCT WASH AND CLIMATE FEASIBILITY STUDY

1. Background

Habitat for Humanity (HFHM) is a non-profit Christian organization whose vision is *“a Malawi where everyone has a decent place to live”*. Since its inception in 1986, Habitat has made significant strides in addressing housing poverty in Malawi. HFHM has assisted over 75,000 families through Vulnerable Group Housing (VGH), Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), Disaster Risk Reduction and Response (DRRR) and Informal Vocation Training programs.

Habitat for Humanity Malawi (HFHM) and Stiftung der Deutschen Lions (SDL) plan to jointly implement a new project from September 2025 to December 2029. This project will focus on the intersection of Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), livelihood, and climate resilience at community and district levels. The consultancy team should submit the following alongside their expression of interest:

- Brief description of their competencies to meet the requirements of the assignment.
- A brief technical bio data of core team members
- A detailed methodology to be used in carrying out the assignment including:
 - Sampling strategy (not just sample size but also urban, rural, age, sex disaggregation, etc.)
 - Ethical procedures
 - Timelines, with deliverables and estimated duration of the assignment
- A detailed professional budget
- Evidence of similar work undertaken recently (not more than 5 years) and references.
